Ans- Goldilocks said sorry to Baby Bear for breaking his chair.

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

A man and a computer are very different from each other.



### Differences between a man and a computer:

| S. No | Topics         | Man   | Computer  |
|-------|----------------|---|---|
| 1.    | Memory         | A man may not remember many things stored in his brain. | A computer can store a lot of information, but it never forgets it. |
| 2.    | Speed          | A man works slowly and can do only one task at a time.  | A computer works very fast and can do many tasks at a time.         |
| 3.    | Accuracy       | A man can make mistakes.                                | Computer never makes mistakes.                                      |
| 4.    | Tiredness      | A man gets tired and need rest.                         | A computer never gets tired and can work for long time.             |
| 5.    | Feeling        | A man has feeling and emotions.                         | A computer has no feeling and emotions.                             |
| 6.    | Take decisions | A man can take decisions on his own.                    | Computer cannot take decisions on its own.                          |
