- **Noun:** A noun is a naming word. It can be the name of a thing, place, person, animal or feeling.
- **Kinds of noun:**
  - > Proper noun
  - > Common noun
  - > Abstract noun
  - > Collective noun
  - > Material noun

- **Proper noun:** A proper noun is a name which refers only to a single person, place or thing and there is no common name for it. The days of the week and the months of the year are also proper nouns. In written English, a proper noun always begins with capital letter.  
**Ex:** I visited the **Taj Mahal** in **India**.
- **Common noun:** Common nouns are naming words that are common to people, places, things and animals etc. Common nouns do not define any particular person, place or thing. They are general names. So, they are not capitalized unless they begin a sentence.  
**Ex:** **Teachers** teach in **school**.
- **Abstract noun:** An abstract noun is a word for something that cannot be seen but is there. It has no physical existence. Generally, it refers to ideas, qualities and conditions.  
**Ex:** Truth, lies, happiness, sorrow, time, friendship, humor, patriotism, etc.
- **Collective noun:** A collective noun is a word for a group of things, people or animals etc. Collective nouns can be both plural and singular.  
**Ex:** An **army** of soldiers.  
A **herd** of cattle.
- **Material noun:** A material noun is the name of any substance that is used for making things.  
**Ex:** milk, gold, plastic etc.

Ch-2-Reproduction in Plants

Plants reproduce mainly in three ways.


- . By seeds
- . By body parts
- . By spores
- . Reproduction from seeds

The process by which seed grows into a seedling is called Germination. The seed requires oxygen, water and optimum temperature for germination.



**Parts of a seed**

- seed is surrounded by outer covering called **coat**
- seed contains baby plant called an **embryo**
- seed stores the reserve food in fleshy **cotyledons** (*Seed Leaves*)




. Reproduction from spores

Some plants reproduce through seed like structure called spores. For example. ferns, mushroom and mould.

Reproduction from body parts. Some plants reproduce from their body parts and not through seeds.

Vegetative reproduction (reproduction from body parts)
